Meanwhile, and simultaneously, Russian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Sequey Lavrov, was having a meeting of « mediation » via his Ukrainian counterpart Dmytro Kuleba and delegation of Turkey, in Antalya, in order to appease the conflict between Russia and Ukraine. MFA Kuleba said « Ukraine will not surrender », while forth Russian side, no perspective of a ceasefire was reached. Another important meeting, was held at the same time, in Versailles France, gathering the 27, EU leaders for a two days informal Summit, in Versailles, under the rotative French Chair of European Union.
